And let us consider how to stir up one another to love and good works, not neglecting to meet together, as is the habit of some, but encouraging one another, and all the more as you see the Day drawing near.

Hebrews 10:24-25

Pastor's Pen

“O clap your hands, all peoples; shout to God with the voice of Joy”
(Psalm 47:1).

Do those words seem to be a strange impossibility? Have fears, worries or burdens choked your life? Does the condition of this world steal your joy? Is the joy expressed in that verse foreign to your daily experience?

I'm sure all of us struggle with this at times. We know we should be able to rejoice in the Lord but our circumstances overwhelm us. We wish that we could have the confident joy of the psalmist.

What enabled the psalmist to have confident joy? First, he knew that God rules over all. Verse 2 says, “For the Lord Most High is to be feared, a great King over all the earth.” Verses 7-8 continue the thought saying, “For God is the King of all the earth; sing praises with a skillful psalm. God reigns over the matrons, God sits on His holy throne.”

Believer, our Lord rules and reigns over everything. We are not left to chance, luck or accident. This world is not out of control. Our Lord is on His throne and we can rest and rejoice in His sovereign kingship.

The psalmist also knew that God loves His people. Verse 4 concludes by saying “...the glory of Jacob whom He loves.” Believer, you are deeply loved by God. He loved you in eternity past and chose you for His own (Jeremiah 31:3; Ephesians 1:3-5). His love was forever proven at Calvary (Romans 5:8). He loves us so much that He wants you to spend eternity with Him (John 3:16; 14:1-3). The One who rules over all loves us with and infinite love. How can we not rejoice in Him?

Last, the psalmist knew that the sovereign, loving God blesses His people. Verses 3-4a say, “He subdues peoples under us and nations under our feet. He chooses our inheritance for us...” The psalmist knew that God has a plan for His people and is actively working out that plan.

Nothing has changed! Believer, God has good plans for you (Jeremiah 29:11). He works those plans in even the most difficult circumstances (Romans 8:28). He uses His plans to fulfill His even greater plan to make us more like Christ (Romans 8:29, Philippians 1:6). God's plans for us are far better, deeper and longer lasting than we call ever conceive. Our present circumstances are part of God's fulfilling His wonderful plans for us. How can we not rejoice?

What a wonderful God we serve! Let's join the psalmist in clapping our hands and shouting to God with the voice of joy.

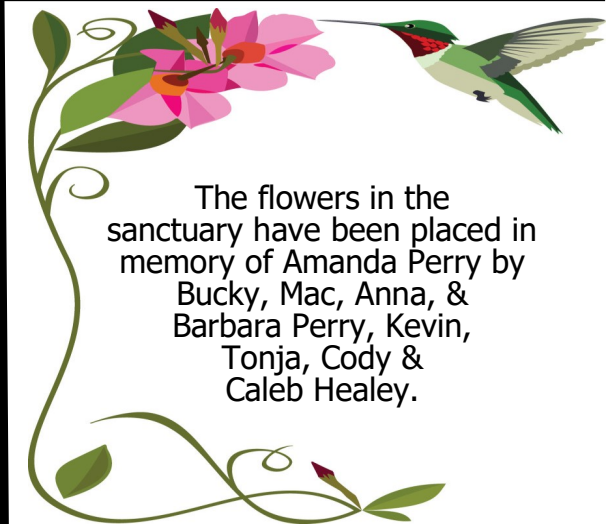
