Men's Bible Study

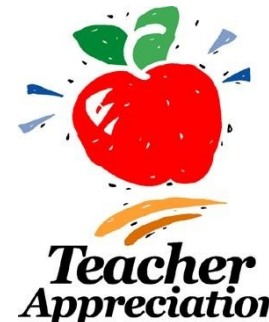

Pastor's Pen

How can we experience God's guidance in our lives? I'm sure that most of us want God to guide us through the decisions and events in our lives. But, how does His leading become a reality?

Israel's experience in the wilderness provides a vivid picture of us. Throughout the wilderness experience, Israel was led by God's wonderful presence and glory. In the daytime He revealed His glory in a cloud. At night he revealed His glory in fire. Numbers 9:15-23 speaks of how God led His people through these revealings of His glory. A study of this passage provides important lessons we must apply in order to experience God's leading in our lives.

First, we must be willing to be led. Although this sounds obvious and simplistic, it is an absolute necessity. God's revelation of His will means nothing if we are not willing to follow – except accountability and judgment. We must be willing to be led to experience the Lord's leading.

Are you willing to be led? It is easy to say that we want God's guidance. It is an entirely different matter to surrender unto the Lord's leading. In Psalm 32:8-9 God tell us, "I will instruct you and teach you in the way which you should go; I will counsel you with My eye upon you. Do not be as the horse or as the mule which have no understanding, whose trappings include bit and bridle to hold them in check, otherwise they will not come near to you." Are we willing to be led – or does God have to use bit and bridle on us?

Next, we must watch for the Lord's leading. Israel had to see the cloud or fire move in order to know what they needed to do. They had to watch for the Lord's leading.

It is the same for us. We must watch for the Lord's leading. We do this by meeting with Him in His Word and in prayer. We also listen to His voice as we go through our day. We also watch His hand work in circumstances. We need always to be watching for our Lord's moving.

Do you watch for His moving? Or do you just go through life on "auto pilot"? Could it be that we don't experience God's leading because we are not even watching for it?

Last, we must follow the Lord in every step. Numbers 9 indicates that Israel would follow the Lord when His revealed glory moved, and they would stay when His revealed glory remained. Verse 22 says they wouldn't move for two days a month or a year if the cloud and fire did not move. They followed the Lord day by day and did not get ahead of Him.

We need that same, simple attitude. If God moves, we need to follow. If God remains, we need to wait. We will only experience His leading if we follow Him step by step.

God wants to lead us just as He led Israel. Will you follow Him?

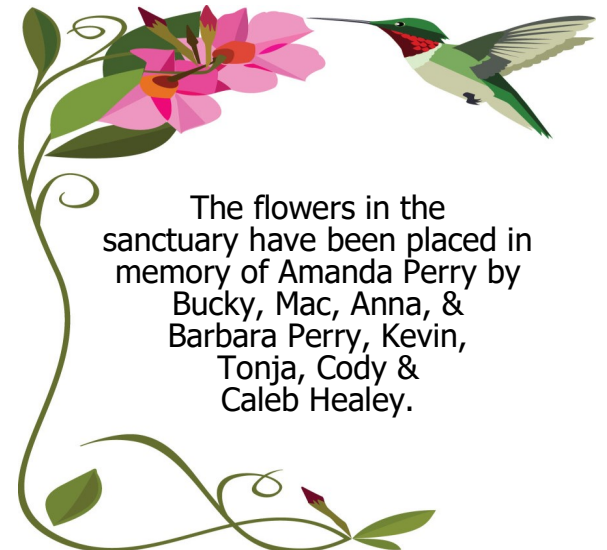
