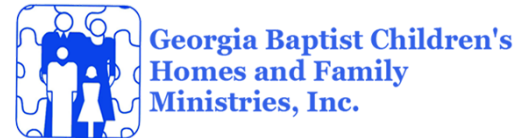

Pastor's Pen

What is your spiritual condition today? Are you in fellowship with the Lord? Are you hearing from the Lord and experiencing Him in your life? Or, is your heart cold and does God seem distant?

If we find ourselves in the latter situation, we don't have to stay that way. We can experience God's closeness again. We can see Him move in our lives in a fresh, new way.

This is clearly seen in the reign of good King Josiah of Judah (2 Chronicles 34-35). Josiah came to the throne, at a very dark period in Judah's history. The nation had been led astray by King Amon. The country was weak and under God's judgment. Under Josiah's rule the country experienced revival, it prospered and was much stronger.

What did Josiah do to experience such a wonderful change? What can we learn from him to our own lives so that we can experience God again?

First, we must seek the Lord. 2 Chronicles 34:3 tells us that Josiah began to seek the Lord when he was still a youth. He wanted to know God and His ways. He wanted to know God's will so he could follow it. He wanted to know God's promises so He could depend upon them. Josiah sought the Lord.

If we are going to experience God, we must seek Him. Jeremiah 29:13 tells us that if we search for God with all our heart, we will find Him. Like Josiah, we need to seek the Lord.

Next, we need to cleanse our lives through confession and repentance. As a result of Josiah's seeking the Lord, Josiah began to purge Judah and the temple of all the idolatry and sinfulness that had permeated the nation. He sought to deal with their sin.

We must deal with the sin in our lives if we are to experience God again. We must clearly call our actions sin (confession) and turn from them in our heart (repentance) and trust the Spirit's power to turn from them in conduct. Like Josiah, we need to seek cleansing from the sins that are keeping us from God.

Next, we need to build ourselves up spiritually. Josiah's next major emphasis was restoring and repairing the temple. He built it up.

1 Corinthians 3:16 tells us that we are a temple of God. Just as Josiah built up the physical temple, we need to build spiritually up the temple of us. We need to strengthen ourselves through Bible study, prayer and fellowship. We must build ourselves up to experience God again.

Last, we must commit to obedience. In 2 Chronicles 34:31-33, Josiah led the nation into a covenant to obey the Lord. Verse 33 says that Judah did not turn from the Lord during the reign of Josiah.

What an example for us. We need to commit ourselves to walking in obedience unto God. We need to stick to that commitment for the rest of our lives. Like, Josiah, we need to obey.

Josiah led Judah into a wonderful time of revival and restoration. The requirements for such an experience have not changed. The only issue is if we will apply them.
