Pastor's Pen

Is there a need in your life? Are you trusting the Lord to meet that need? Philippians 4:19 says, "And my God will supply all your needs according to His riches in glory in Christ Jesus." Whatever we need our Father will provide. We can trust Him.

God's creation of Eve as a wife for Adam (Genesis 2:18-25) is a powerful illustration of this truth. While the account gives a beautiful picture of marriage, it shows how God can be trusted for every need.

It is interesting to note that God saw Adam's need before Adam saw it. Adam did not know he had a need. He had been alone since God created time, so he did not know there was a void. God said, "It is not good for man to be alone..." (Genesis 2:18). God was the first to see Adam's need.

Believer, God sees your need. He saw it long before you did. You may have just discovered a need that God has seen before He created you. You may be worrying and fretting over a need that God understood before He created the world. Whatever you need, God knows about it. He knew about it long before you discovered it.

Amazingly, God takes the responsibility of meeting our needs. Genesis 2:18 continues "I will make him a helper..." Think of that! Before Adam even knew he had a need, God had already planned a solution! God also made that solution His responsibility. The passage shows Adam continuing in obedience and God creating the solution and bringing the solution to Adam.

What a picture for us! God will meet our needs. He will create the solutions. He will bring solutions to us. We simply need to follow Him and obey Him. This is what our Lord meant when He said, "But seek first His kingdom and His righteousness, and all these things will be added to you" (Matthew 6:33). As we follow and obey, God meets our needs. He opens doors, creates opportunities, gives abilities and sometimes moves in miraculous ways. God makes meeting our needs His responsibility.

Last, God meets our needs perfectly. The passage ends with the couple living in oneness in Eden. God's solutions are always the best solutions. Our "solutions" usually create more problems. Abraham and Sarah discovered this when they sought a child through Hagar and Ishmael was born (Genesis 16). God's solutions are never "forced" or "half-way". God's solutions are not only solutions. They are blessings.

Believer, are you facing a need? Take it to the Lord. He will perfectly meet it.
