Pastor's Pen

How can we experience security in these days? It seems as if we are surrounded on every side by violence, unrest, uncertainty and instability. It makes it even worse when the trends are for these things to increase. How can we experience security in days like these?

We are not the first to experience dark, difficult days. In Psalm 3, David is in one of the darkest chapters of his life. David's own son is leading a coup against him! David is on the run from his own son! How much worse could a situation be?

Yet, David ended the psalm on a confident, secure note. He wrote, "Salvation belongs to the Lord; Your blessing be upon Your people!" (verse 8).

What enabled David to have such security in such an awful situation? First, David knew that God was present. In verse 3 David wrote, "But You, O Lord, are a shield about me, my glory, and the One who lift my head." David didn't think of the Lord as "out there" or "up there." David knew that God was present and working. Only when we realize that God is personally with us will we be able to experience security.

David also knew that God listened to his prayers and answered them. Verse 4 reads, "I was crying to the Lord with my voice, and He answered me from His holy mountain." In the midst of such a horrible situation, David knew that God listens to the cries of His children. We must have that same confidence if we are going to experience security in these difficult days.

Third, David knew God protected him. In verses 5-6 David wrote, "I lay down and slept; I awoke, for the Lord sustains me. I will not be afraid of ten thousands of people who have set themselves against me round about." Yes, David acted wisely with weapons and guards, but he knew that God was his ultimate protector. David knew that no one could approach him without first going through God. We can experience security even in the most unstable times when we rest in the protection of our Lord.

Last, David experienced security in the present crisis when he remembered God's deliverances in the past. He wrote, "Arise, O Lord; save me, O my God! For You have smitten all my enemies on the cheek; You have shattered the teeth of the wicked." David faced his current crisis by remembering that God had never failed him. When we remember that we serve a God who has never failed us or any of His people, we can experience security in even the most difficult of times.

Child of God, these are difficult times. Conditions will probably get even worse. Praise God that He is a never failing source of security for His people.

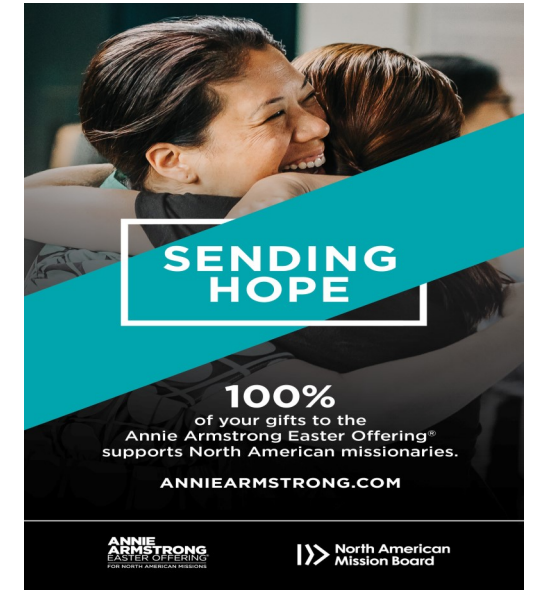
