## From Our Minister of Music and Family Ministries

Have you ever seen a beautiful piece of artwork designed by a famous artist or listened to a musical arrangement that left you in awe? Maybe you've watched a movie or a YouTube video of someone inventing something great and you found yourself thinking, how in the world did they do that?

Well God has that same effect. He turns heads and blows minds, leaving people to wonder; how in the world did He do that? How did He take nothing and create so much? How did He suspend the sun and the moon in space?

The Bible says in Psalm 19:1-4, "The heavens declare the glory of God; the skies proclaim the work of His hands. Day after day they pour forth speech; night after night they reveal knowledge. They have no speech; they use no words; no sound is heard from them. Yet their voice goes out into all the earth, their words to the ends of the world. In the heavens God has pitched a tent for the sun."
