From Our Minister of Music and Family Ministries

One of the most recognized advertisements on television is the MasterCard commercial which lists items with their prices for an activity. As the advertisement ends, some experience or great memory you have had because you purchased these items is labeled as "priceless". MasterCard is telling the viewer that the money you spend is always worth the reward.

As Christians, God commands us to reach out to our family, friends, and community for Christ. Not only should we be focused on growing in our relationship with Christ, but we should always show His love through us to others and teach them about Him. We may not always see the results of our labors, but that should never discourage us from the task.

This past Halloween night, during the Community Open House, our Youth gave out 500 bags which consisted of a Salvation Tract and candy. As we are giving these out, I realized that most of these tracts are tossed in the trash can. We have no way of knowing if a kid or parent will even take the time to look at them.

Fortunately...this year, in a non-direct way, we received confirmation of our labors.

Julie West has been filling in as the instructor for the Christian Learning Center this semester. Every morning, she goes to the Middle School in order to ride the bus with the CLC students to the Family Ministries Building. As she was walking up to the school on November 1st, she noticed an instructor looking at something with a girl, and then the instructor was shouting for joy! He looked at Julie and told the student, "Tell Mrs. West what you just told me." Julie looked and the student showed her the Salvation Tract we had distributed and showed Julie the back portion where there was a prayer asking Jesus to be her Savior! She had read the whole tract and prayed the prayer.

I immediately see three things here which are priceless:

- 1) A seed has been planted in a young person that will change her life forever.
- 2) There are teachers to whom students can go when they are excited about things of God and need prayer support.
- 3) We can use this as an example to encourage our young people to continue to outreach even though they may not see a reward.

The fact that we even heard this story is a blessing from God. The teacher and the student that shared this with Julie had no idea we were the group that gave the tracts out.

We don't fulfill God's commands for what we get out of them – but encouragement is always nice.
