Pastor's Pen

What are you needing today? Is it physical, emotional, spiritual or financial? Whatever you are needing God has promised to meet that need. Philippians 4:19 says "And my God will supply all your needs according to His riches in glory in Christ Jesus."

While we are probably very familiar with that promise, we often find it difficult to calmly trust our Lord in times of need. It is easy to memorize Philippians 4:19. Sermons and Bible Studies on the verse are interesting and enjoyable. However, truly resting on the promise is a different matter.

We will find it much easier to rest on the promise if we know the One who made the promise. When we look closer at Him, trusting Him becomes far

easier.

Our Lord's feeding of the 5000 (John 6:1-13) reveals the heart and ways of the Lord. These revealed truths make it easier to trust our Lord in the face of our need.

As we read this passage, we first discover that our Lord was actually the first to see the problem. In verse 5, it was our Lord who raised the question about feeding the crowd. No one came to Him with news about a shortage of food.

It is the same for you. Your need may have surprised you, but it did not surprise God. He knew in eternity past that you would have that need today. You may have just discovered your need. He has known it all along.

Second, He already knows what He is going to do. Verse 6 says our Lord knew what He was going to do when He asked Philip about feeding the crowd. Our Lord already had a plan. Since He knew about this situation in eternity past, this means He had already made His plans for meeting the need in eternity past.

Think of that in relation to your need. God already knows what He is going to do! He knew what He was going to do from eternity past! You may have just discovered that you have a need, but He has always known what He was going to do to meet that need.

Next, we see that God's provision is always sufficient. God provides by creating an amount that is equal to the need. Sometimes He blesses an insufficient amount so that it miraculously covers the need (v.9-11). Whatever God provides, it is always enough.

Last, God's provision provides a blessing beyond meeting the immediate need. Our Lord's provision met the need for the multitude. There were also 12 baskets left over. Not only did our Lord feed the multitude, but He also provided for the disciples. He blessed them physically with the food and spiritually in seeing Him work. Their "cup" overflowed (Psalm 23:5). They were fed and blessed. God's provision always provides a blessing far beyond merely meeting the need.

Are you facing a need? Our God is far greater than any need that we will ever face. He'll provide for you. He'll bless you. Trust Him.
